

Conflict Minerals Statement

Section 1502 of the U.S. Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act requires companies (“issuers”) to disclose the use and origin of the minerals tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold (3TG) that are necessary to the functionality or production of their products. These minerals are commonly referred to as *Conflict Minerals*.

Spark Holland is committed to responsible sourcing and to ensuring that minerals used in our products do not contribute to human rights abuses. Our objective is to comply with all requirements of Section 1502 and to work only with suppliers who share our commitment to ethical, environmental, and socially responsible practices.

We continuously monitor developments in SEC regulations related to Conflict Minerals and work closely with our supply chain to ensure full compliance. We expect our suppliers to provide accurate information and to maintain practices aligned with our environmental and human rights standards.
